Public Opinion Poll: Residents of Mongolia

March - April 2022

DETAILED METHODOLOGY

- The survey was conducted on behalf of the International Republican Institute's <u>Center for Insights in Survey Research</u> by <u>Independent Research Institute of Mongolia (IRIM).</u>
- Data collection was conducted between March 01 April 26, 2022 through computer-assisted telephone interviews.
- The sample consisted of n=2,500 residents of Mongolia aged 18 and over, with access to a mobile phone.
- A multi-stage probability sampling method was used to design a nationally representative sample. The contact information list of the households was compiled from the IRIM's internal database. The sample was stratified by region and by urban/rural residency, followed by random selection of primary sampling units (PSUs) within each stratum. Households were selected by simple random sampling, and respondents were selected by the last birthday method.
- The data was weighted by gender and age groups based on the <u>NSO data for</u> <u>population of Mongolia</u>.
- The response rate was 19 percent.
- The margin of error for the full sample is \pm 1.9 percent.
- Charts and graphs may not add up to 100 percent due to rounding.






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In general, would you say that our country is heading in the right direction or in the wrong direction?




Speaking personally, over the past 6 months, how has your overall quality of life changed?



What is the most important problem facing our country today? (Spontaneous response; up to three responses permitted)




What is the most important problem facing our country today? (Spontaneous response; up to three responses permitted)




How would you describe the current economic situation of your household?




How do you think Mongolia can best revive the economy?





Which of the following is the best way to develop democracy in Mongolia?




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How likely are ordinary people able to influence decisions made in our country?



Through what activities can ordinary people influence decisions made in our country?




Through what activities can ordinary people influence decisions made in our country?




Ratings of Parties, Government, Personalities, and Institutions




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Do you agree or disagree that political parties are doing enough to address the needs of voters like you?







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



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How important or unimportant is it that all members of our country's adult population are included in political decision making? How important is that [...] are included?







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
Do you believe that corruption in our country is a serious problem or not?




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Which media platform do you use most frequently to gain political news and information?






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


How frequently do you encounter information in the media, including social media, that you believe is misleading or false?



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



To what extent is misleading or false information in the media problematic for our country?







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
